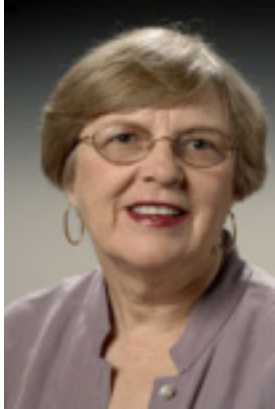

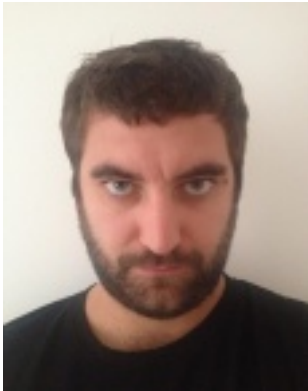

Filip says: "After undertaking five years of doctoral studies in sociology at the University of Bristol I benefited from a one-year postdoc at ISS, in at least two important ways. Primarily, I valued (temporal) autonomy I could enjoy at ISS. Hence I could work on my research in an organic way and carefully prepare some of my theses and parts of dissertation for publication.
