

## **Director's Directive 8/2022**

Ranking of students according to their academic performance in the previous academic year for study programs in a foreign language at Institute of Sociological Studies

1. This directive is effective to these study programmes at the Institute of Sociological Studies:

Bachelor in Social Sciences (SOSCI),

Master in Public and Social Policy (PASP)

Master in Sociology of Contemporary Societies (SCS)

Master in Society, Communication and Media (SCM)

following the Dean's Measure 15/2022 Procedure for submitting requests for reducing or waiving the fee for studies in a foreign language

2. Methodology for ranking of students:

For every student Grade Point Average (GPA) in the previous academic year is computed as the weighted average of all results from previous academic year; the weights are number of credits assigned to individual courses.

The best student according to ranking can receive fee reduction of 4.000 EUR, the 2nd best can receive fee reduction of 2.000 EUR (if there are more than 10 students in the study programme). If number of students in the study programme exceeds 20 students, one more student (with the 3<sup>rd</sup> best GPA) is eligible for fee reduction of 2.000 EUR.

3. According to the Dean's Measure 15/2022 students with the best GPAs will be contacted by International Office for the possibility to ask the Rector for reducing the fee for next academic year.
