

Evaluation rules for the payment of an extraordinary scholarships

Publications in foreign and domestic journals with IF, book in prestigious foreign publishing house	20 points
1st Q, Oxford, Cambridge Uni Press:	50 points
Publications in a foreign or domestic journal in another database, publication of a monograph, chapters in books:	10 points
Nonbibliometric outputs that have a clear social impact and can not be evaluated as book, article, publication (eg research reports for major institutions), conferences abroad:	8 points
Participation in important events of the department (matriculation, final state exams, etc.), home conference:	2 points
The second and every other opponent's review:	1 point
Bachelor's thesis:	4 points
Grant submission (can not be rejected based on formal errors):	4 points
Obtaining a grant:	8 points
Participation in the events of undergraduate students Karel Marsch and other events by Miroslava:	1 point
